



We've had another busy week in Year One! In Maths, the children have been learning about 2D shapes and discussing their different properties. We used little tricks to help us remember that a hexagon has six sides (both words have 'x' in them), that a pentagon has five sides (we hold a pen with five fingers) and octagon has eight sides (an octopus has eight tentacles). We have included number bonds to five, ten and twenty on the Magic Maths this week as this is an ongoing objective to secure.

In English, we have looked at a beautiful poem called, 'White is the Moon' by Valerie Greeley. Not only does it have delightful illustrations, it is full of adjectives, verbs and rhyme that the children have used in lists and sentences. On Monday, they worked in small groups to read a verse each and then performed it to the class. We were very proud of them.
