What a super week we have had! We have written sentences about Mr Men and Little Miss characters, with a focus on handwriting, correct punctuation and adjectives. In Phonics, we have looked at 'er, ir and ur' and read different words containing these digraphs.

In Maths, we have continued to do quick recall of number sentences in our heads and learnt about measuring length and height using non-standard and standard measurements (cm). We have loved the discussions and the practical work involved in this.



During the half term break, you may like to see how clever we have become with our skipping. It has been our focus in PE this half-term.
