

Crazy Creations - Activity Ideas

We have put all the activities you experienced on this template, we hope you have fun doing some of them at home



Alien Figures

- Choose a box for the body of your alien
- Use tinfoil to cover the whole body
- Use glue or sellotape to stick on any additional features (using card, glitter, tissue paper, pipe cleaners, googly eyes etc)

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Blow Paint Aliens

- Choose the colours of your aliens!
- Use a pipette and drop some paint blobs onto your paper.
- Use a big 'huff and puff' blow to spread the paint across the page.
- Use runny glue to stick on your eyes.
- Use black pen to add a mouth.

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Alien Headbands

- Collect card and measure your child's head (adults to staple and secure)
- Choose the media and materials you would like to use - make your designs as crazy as possible!!!
- Decorate the headband first using paint, pens, glitter etc
- Fix on all of your eyes and boppers using sellotape.

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Puffy Paint

- Make the puffy paint
 - a teaspoon of shaving foam
 - a quarter teaspoon of PVA
 - a quarter teaspoon of plain flour
 (Although, I never measure anymore. A big squirt of shaving foam, a small squirt of glue and a spoonful of flour does the job)
- Choose the planets to make with your child and create your space scene together
- Use glue to stick on any additional objects (using card, glitter, tissue paper etc)

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Flying Saucer

- Collect a paper plate
- Choose the media and materials you would like to use - make your designs as bright as possible!
- Use a 'pom pom' for your alien and place in the centre.
- Use a plastic (small) pot to create the looking glass for your alien and secure with sellotape.

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Rockets

- Collect coloured shapes and ask your child to name the shapes.
- Choose the media and materials you would like to use for the rocket design.
- Use glue to stick your rocket together.
- Add some SPACE details - planets, stars, aliens etc

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Constellation Art

- Choose a constellation and talk with your child about the shape it makes in the night sky.
- Use the stars and chalk to create your own constellation together.
- Let your child have a go at sounding out and labelling their creation.
- Take it home and try and spot it in the night sky together 😊

3D Rockets

- Choose the size and shape of your bottle.
- Use a tinfoil to cover it and select the resources you need for all the features.
- Use tissue paper and ask your child to rip it into long strips (great for their fine motor control).
- Draw you and your child in the space rocket 😊
