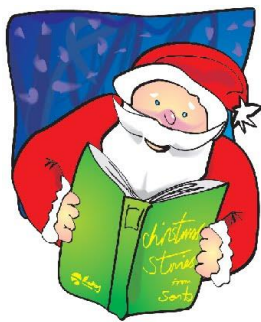




Home Learning - 30th November 2017

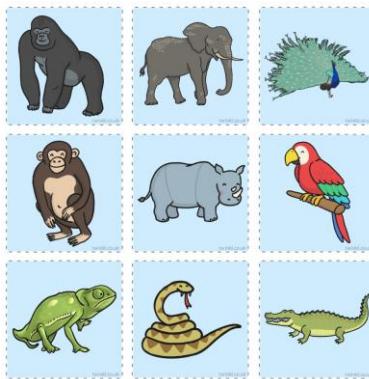
