Dear Parents,

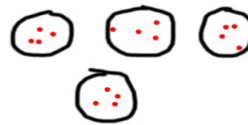

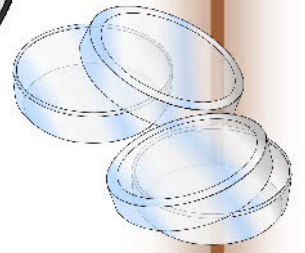


Teddy Bear's Picnic



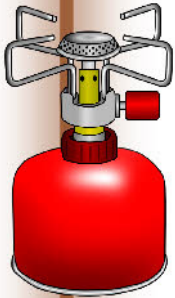

Home Learning - Maths Capacity

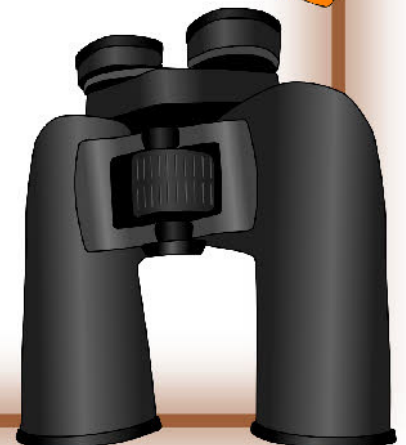
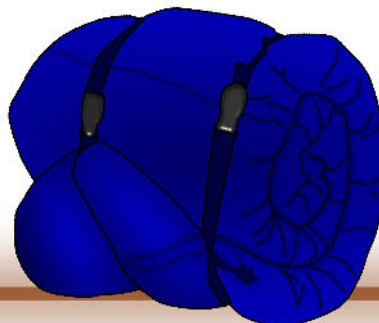
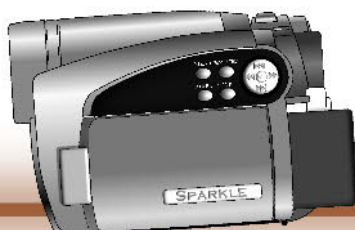
This week we have been looking at measuring and capacity. For Home Learning, please can you explore a range of jars and bottles that can be found around your home?

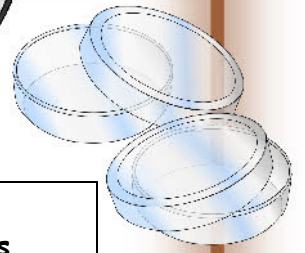


Please question your children... which container holds the most/least liquid? Ask the children to estimate (guess) first of all. How can you find out? Explore and have fun!

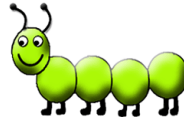
