Safeguarding Tips

With the notice from Surrey Police last week, about stranger danger, it served as a good reminder about how vigilant we all need to be. The following link is a suggestion for setting up a password between yourself and your child. This could be used if, for whatever reason, you aren't able to collect your children and are asking someone else to pick them up instead.
