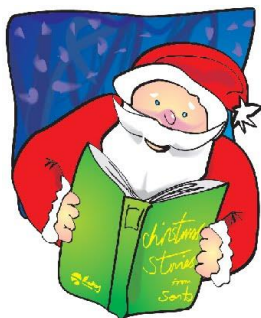




Home Learning - 7th December 2017

Dear Parents,

In English, we have been learning to spell, recognise and use common exception word spellings (some examples are - could, would, should, parents, Christmas etc) and the children have enjoyed using them in their writing. In Maths, we have been learning how to divide using apparatus and jottings to help us.

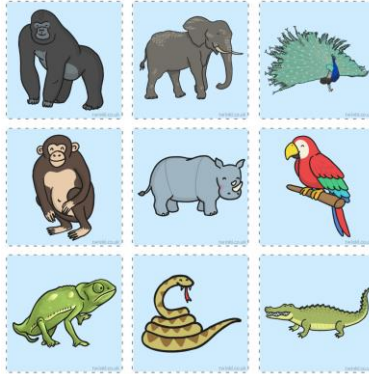
